

FIRST WEEK

30th September to 11th October

This campaign which is basically a three point programme to inculcate awareness, action programme and a sustainable community for a cleaner and better India, initiated by the Central Government is being followed in DPS Raipur with complete zest and vigor. Enthusiastic students of classes I to V were sensitized towards cleanliness by an assembly conducted by the primary wing and by administration of the cleanliness pledge on the 30th of September. DPS fraternity joined hands to get the campus and the surroundings clean on the 2nd of October. Classes IV to XII had an orientation programme from the 7th to the 10th of October to develop and generate awareness about Swachch Bharat and its repercussions. 11th of October witnessed excited and passionate students participating in an assortment of literary and creative pursuits like paragraph writing, elocution and drawing pertaining to the same.
